

Tips on measuring for curtains and blinds.

Curtains

1. Fit the curtain track or pole before measuring.
2. Where possible, add a minimum of 15cm either side of the window to allow maximum natural light levels when the curtains are drawn back.
Ideally a pole should be fitted 15cm above the window.



3. Measure the width of the track, or pole, not the window.
See A above.

If using a track, measure from end to end. Include any overlaps in your measurements.

If using a pole, measure the width between both finials.

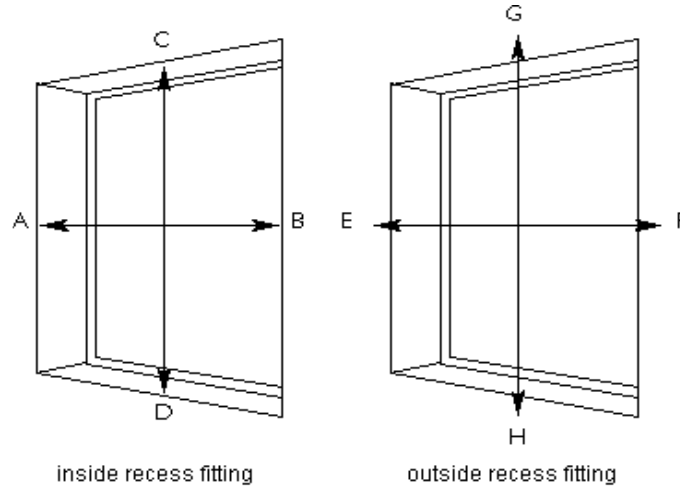
4. Measure your desired finished curtain drop.
See B above.

If using track, measure from the top of the track to where you wish the curtain to finish.

If using a pole, measure from the bottom of the curtain rings to where you wish the curtain to finish.

Blinds

Decide whether you require the blind to be fixed inside or outside the window recess.



1. For inside recess, measure the width from A to B at the top and bottom of the recess.
Measure the height from C to D on both sides of the recess.
Note any obstructions, i.e. handles.
2. For outside recess, decide how far above the window you require the blind. Measure from this point to where you want the blind to finish, G to H.
Measure the width of the window, and then add how far you wish the blind to finish each side, E to F, this should be a minimum of 5cm.
